BODIES OF EVIDENCE

Kay Bishop (QHTA)

In this session Kay will explore the changing role of science and technology in the understanding of archaeology, with particular reference to human remains. The examination of human remains has been controversial and the application of techniques familiar to many through CSI shows has produced quite startling and new interpretations.

Kay Bishop (QHTA)

In this session, Kay will continue the theme of sources, but instead of physical remains from the past, Kay will investigate the nature of ancient written sources. She will explore the way students need to investigate written sources and she will address the demanding task of not only using written sources wisely but also evaluating these sources.
