YOUNG HISTORIANS' WORKSHOP

Monday 30th April and Tuesday 1st May

Teachers are invited to submit the name of **one** student from their Year 11 or 12 Ancient History or Modern History classes to attend the Young Historians' Workshop to be held at the State Library of Queensland from 30th April to 1st May 2012.

Only **ten** students will be chosen and, of these, preference will be given to **two** students from rural or remote areas who meet the criteria. These two students will have travel costs supplemented to the value of \$600 each and will be billeted in Brisbane. Country students must be willing to be billeted or be willing to fund any alternative arrangements.

The State Library staff will work with students to investigate a historical issue of their choice and to develop a wide range of research skills.

Students will be selected using the following criteria:

- Student is currently achieving an "A" Grade in assessment
- Student has already demonstrated high level research skills
- Student has clearly indicated an interest in continuing history studies in the future
- Student is capable of sharing experiences of the two day workshop with fellow students and others

Teachers should complete the attached application form.
